INKULULEKO YESIZWE ASSOCIATION SUPPORTS GOVERNMENT'S 100 PERSON THRESHOLD FOR CHURCH GATHERINGS

The announcement of President Ramaphosa regarding the position taken by cabinet in curbing the spread of the Corona Virus that is Devastating to most parts of the world including our country refers.
